

OrchLab Instrument clues

If you want to challenge your group, us the following clues as calls instead of instrument names! Use the call sheets provided to dictate the order in which you read these clues, or make up your own order (but make sure you write it down so you can check the winning card!)

Woodwind

- **Flute:** A member of the woodwind family. You have to blow over a hole in the top of the instrument to make a sound.
- **Clarinet:** A member of the woodwind family, it is normally made of a black wood and uses a single reed. It is sometimes used in jazz music.
- Oboe: A member of the woodwind family, which is played using a double reed. It
 is normally the first thing you will hear at a concert as it tunes the orchestra by
 playing a long 'A'.
- Bassoon: A larger instrument of the woodwind family, normally made from
 maple wood. This instrument is played with a double reed, that fits into a curved
 metal pipe called a crook.

Brass

- French horn: An instrument in the brass family which has a circular body
- **Trumpet:** The smallest member of the orchestral brass family. You are likely to hear this instrument play victorious fanfare music.
- **Trombone:** A member of the brass family, that has a slide that the player can use to change the note being played.
- Tuba: The lowest instrument of the brass family in the orchestra.

Strings

- **Violin:** The smallest member of the string family in the orchestra. There are many of this instrument in the orchestra.
- Cello: This instrument has four strings and looks like a large violin. You play it
 with a bow (or by plucking its strings) while sitting down and holding it upright
 between your legs.
- **Double bass:** The largest member of the string family in the orchestra. This instrument is sometimes used in jazz music.

Percussion and others

- Bass drum: Part of the percussion family, it can make a big bang!
- Xylophone: A percussion instrument consisting of a series of wooden bars in a row, that get smaller as the note gets higher. This instrument is played using sticks.
- **Harp:** An instrument that is played by plucking its many strings with your fingers which are set in an open triangular frame. It often plays angelic music.
- **Piano:** This instrument is played by pressing down on black and white keys on a keyboard.
